


## Maternity – Delivery Documentation

### Delivery Documentation

1. In Interactive View and I&O, go to Labour and Delivery Band
2. Click on the relevant sections to document details of the delivery, for example, click on Delivery Information Section. If there are multiple babies, click on Dynamic Group (Grid).

3. When documenting Labour Onset Methods, there is Conditional Logic (triangle with and arrow inside) this signifies that when certain responses are selected, eg induced, there will be additional fields that will open up for further documentation.
  - This includes Delivery Type, Vaginal Delivery with forceps and vacuum was selected, prompting further documentation.

Document Stages of Labour Calculations in the Stages of Labour Calculations Band:

- Ensure you have completed the full cervical dilatation in the field “Cervix Dilation”, where the conditional logic opens up and prompts you to document the Complete Cervix Dilatation Date /Time.
- Labour Onset, Date/Time should be documented at this time if not already documented.

<b>PAIN ASSESSMENT</b>			

- Document in the Stages of Labour Calculations, Active Pushing Started with Date/Time.
- Double Click on Length of Labour, 1<sup>st</sup> Stage ( calculation in **minutes** appears).
- Double Click on Length of Labour, 1<sup>st</sup> Stage ( calculation in **hours** appears).
- Note, the same principle on the remainder calculations remains to document further.
