Reviewing Tasks are outlined for three specific types of orders:

- MEWS/PEWS/Sepsis
- Topical Patch Removal
- Blood Transfusion

When the Discern Alert window displays it will contain instructions on how to manage your patient.




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

The Provider Notification section in Interactive View and I&O will display. Document the details as needed.



- 2. Double click task to review.




The Patch Removal window will display. Document and removal as needed.

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

1. Click on the Single Patient Task List (SPTL) Single Patient Task List from the Menu to view your Task(s) which would be listed as Pending.





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
