

Telephone Dictation for Historical McKesson Reports

To dictate reports for patients registered in McKesson before CST Cerner went live, please follow these steps.

- 1. Call the dictation access phone number: 1-855-666-3240 and then enter the following.
- 2. Enter Unique ID (MSP# or assigned) + # key.
- 3. Enter Facility code + # key. (example 390 for LGH)

 Note: Even for historical dictations, please use the new facility code

4. Enter Work type number + # key. (example 10900)
Use the following generic work-type numbers

Operative Report	10800
Procedure Note Other	10900

- 5. Enter patient encounter number + # key (If dictating on a patient from the old legacy McKesson system enter the patient's McKesson MRN or Encounter # if known, or if not known enter 55555 + #). The system will state "Patient name is not found or unique."
- 6. Press 1 to accept and continue or 2 to correct.
- 7. Press 2 to dictate.
 - NOTE: Please dictate the patient's identifying information such as name, MRN, encounter#
- 8. Press 8 to save dictation and start new.
- 9. Press 5 to save dictation and log off.
